



2026-2027 NOMINATION REPORT FOR THE CONCRETE BC BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Concrete BC Bylaw 6a states that: *“The affairs of the Society shall be managed by a Board of not less than Eleven (11) Directors and not more than nineteen (19) Directors, made up of a simple majority of ready-mixed concrete producers on the day of election.”*

The following 10 Directors were elected in 2025 and have one year remaining on their term. (P designates a ready-mix producer):

This leaves 9 available seats on the 19 Seat Board of Directors. The following names appear on the 2026 Election Ballot as they submitted nomination forms, and this fulfills the simple majority outlined in the Bylaws, with a minimum of 8 out of the 15 proposed seats being filled by a Producer.

1. **JEFF ADAMS – Senior Account Executive, FuelEx Energy – Lower Mainland.** Jeff has worked for FuelEx for over 10 years and has 35 years experience in the Private sector.
